### **STAIN REMOVER**

#### Recipe #1

- 1/2 Cup Ammonia
- 1/2 Cup White Vinegar
- 2 Tablespoons Liquid Laundry Detergent (Use HomeMade)
- 2 Quarts Water

Mix well, and store in spray bottle.

\*Hint - Reuse your "Spray and Wash" bottle.

#### Recipe #2

- 1/2 Cup Ammonia
- 1/2 Cup Liquid Laundry Detergent (Use HomeMade)
- 1/2 Cup White Vinegar
- 1/2 Cup Water

Mix well, and store in spray bottle.

\*Hint - Reuse your "Spray and Wash" bottle.

- 1/4 Cup Borax or Washing Soda
- 2 Cups Cold Water

Sponge on and let dry, or soak the fabric in Borax mixture before washing in soap and cold water.

### Recipe #4

*For Heavily Stained Clothing*

**\*\*NOTE: This is for use with white cotton, nylon and polyester only.**

- 1/2 Cup Liquid Laundry Detergent (Use HomeMade)
- 1/2 Cup Electric Dishwasher Detergent
- 1/2 Cup Non-Chlorinated Bleach **or** Ammonia, **Not Both**

Soak clothes in washing machine overnight or until stains disappear. Launder as usual.
